

CAT phone secure metal housing

- Heavy gauge steel
- Powder coated finish
- Wall or shelf mounting
- Special support for card reader
- Modem point socket
- Pre-drilled for stout fixing screws
- Finely finished – all corners radiussed for safety and clean appearance

Product Description

The CAT phone metal housing has been developed to allow most versions of the ATL Telecom Berkshire phone, including those with a modem point fitted, to be securely fixed to a wall or tabletop. Being manufactured from 1.6mm steel it is extremely sturdy and allows a much stronger wall fixing to be made than with the standard plastic wall mount. With pre-drilled holes in the base, it can be screwed down to prevent the phone from being knocked on to the floor from a shelf or desk.

A modem socket is provided in the side for applications that need this facility, and a blanking plug is available when it is not required. The main line cord entry is at the back and is arranged so that the cord is not trapped whether the housing is wall or shelf mounted.

The phone is held in place by a hook feature at the bottom of the housing and a removable steel plate at the top. The top plate is retained by stainless steel Torx security screws.

The housing is finished in charcoal grey powder coat and the colour matches the handset cord and buttons of the standard CAT phone.
